Cognia provides the Index of Education Quality (IEQ), a holistic measure of overall performance based on a comprehensive set of standards and review criteria; Leadership Capacity, Learning Capacity, and Resource Capacity.



An IEQ of 275 and above indicates the institution reached Impact level and is engaged in practices sustained over time and are becoming ingrained in the culture of the institution.

# TerraNova Testing Program

### TERRANOVA

TerraNova is a series of standardized achievement tests taken by the students of grades 3 – 8. It consists of mathematics, spelling, vocabulary, social studies, reading, science, language arts, and other specific areas.



In 2022, 73% of students in grades 3–8 increased or maintained their levels Compared with 2021 results. Increases were distributed amongst the grades in the categories of reading, language and math.

## New York State Tests



Students continued to outperform parochial schools across the Diocese of Brooklyn by 11% meeting or exceeded English language Arts (ELA) standards during the 2021–22 academic year. As much as 83% of students scored at levels 3 & 4.

We exceeded New York City Public School ELA scores by as much as 23%.



In math ICCA outperformed schools in the Diocese of Brooklyn by as much as 28% meeting or exceeding Math standards during the 2021–2022 academic year. As much as 71% of our students scored at levels 3 & 4. We also exceeded New York City Public School scores by as much as 29%.
